

OREGON SHEEP COMMISSION

Producer Assessment Report

The current assessment rate is \$ 0.50 per head for the sale of each live sheep/lamb sold by an Oregon producer. The assessment is to be deducted from the proceeds of the sale by the Handler (first purchaser) and forwarded to the Commission; however, if the handler is located out-of-state and unwilling to forward the assessment, the responsibility falls to the individual sheep producer. Payments are due on a quarterly basis, but may be submitted monthly.

Please note that individual producer information submitted to the Commission is considered confidential. Only aggregated information is considered public information.
