

Funding Application to Oregon Sheep Commission

The purpose of the Oregon Sheep Commission is to support, promote and enhance Oregon's production of lamb and wool products. To accomplish these goals, the Commission may allocate assessment funds to specific projects designed to address industry problems or industry advancement through research, promotions, or education.

Organizations and individuals interested in requesting funding support from the Commission must submit a written application by May 1, for the upcoming fiscal year. The Commission's fiscal year is July 1 to June 30. The annual budget hearing is generally scheduled during May or June.

Written application may be sent to the OSC office or via e-mail. Deadline is May 1st. Postmark is acceptable. Applicants will be notified of the Commission's decision after June 30th. For information about the Commission meeting, contact the OSC office.

Completed applications must include the following information and may be as detailed as necessary. A written report must be submitted following the completion of the project. Copies of any media coverage, photos or promotional materials distributed to the public and acknowledging the Commission's support should be included with the report.

1. Project title
2. Name and contact information for organization or individual submitting the application
3. Describe the proposed project in detail, explaining how the completed project will benefit Oregon's sheep industry.
4. Amount of funds requested and overall budget for the project. Indicate other sources of financial or in-kind support, if applicable.
5. How will the project be evaluated or results measured?
6. How will the Commission's support be acknowledged?
7. Timeline for overall project and date the final report will be submitted.
8. For research projects, indicate whether the Commission will be granted full control over the resulting material or will be granted permission to publicize and distribute the results to the industry.

Please include a one page summary of the proposed project, with the project title and the amount of funds requested as your cover page.

Note: The funding recipient releases the Commission from all claims or demands arising out of, or in connection with, the funded event/project.
